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**WHEREAS**, an earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of 8.7 occurred off the east coast of Kamchatka, Russia at 9:25 am CHST on Wednesday July 30, 2025; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Weather Service, Pacific Tsunami Warning Center, has issued a Tsunami Advisory; stating that based on all available data there is a threat to Guam of sea level fluctuations and strong ocean currents that could be a hazard along beaches, in harbors, and in coastal waters; and

**WHEREAS**, the earliest estimated time that hazardous sea level fluctuations and strong ocean currents may begin in Guam is 2:37 pm CHST on Wednesday July 30, 2025, and can persist for many hours or longer; and

**WHEREAS**, recommended actions include persons in the ocean should get out of the water and persons near the ocean should move away from beaches and harbors; and

**WHEREAS**, under a Tsunami Advisory a tsunami with potential for strong currents or waves dangerous to those in or very near the water is expected or occurring; there may be flooding of beach and harbor areas; and people are instructed to stay out of the water and away from beaches and waterways; and
