**ORDER ACCEPTING
APPLICATION TO RESIGN
UNDER RULE 24**

This matter comes before the Court on the “Confidential Sworn Application to Resign from the Practice of Law on Guam Pursuant to GRLDEDP 24,” submitted by Bruce A. Bradley on July 22, 2026, which included Attorney Bradley’s sworn written statement submitted in accordance with Rule 24(b) of the Guam Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement and Disability Proceedings (“GRLDEDP”). In accordance with Rule 24(c), the court notified the Investigative Committee of the Comprehensive Lawyer Regulatory System (“Committee”) of the receipt of the Application to Resign and gave the Committee the opportunity to submit, within 15 days, any fact or argument it may desire prior to the court entering an order accepting or rejecting the tendered resignation. The court received the Committee’s response on August 12, 2026.

The court has reviewed the Application and accompanying materials, including the Committee’s response, and finds that Attorney Bradley has voluntarily sought leave to resign from the practice of law in Guam under Rule 24 of GRLDEDP. The court further finds that the Application satisfies the requirements of Rule 24.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. That Bruce A. Bradley's resignation from the practice of law in Guam is **ACCEPTED**, under Rule 24 of the Guam Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement and Disability Proceedings, effective immediately upon entry of this Order;
2. That Bruce A. Bradley's name shall be immediately removed from the roll of attorneys authorized to practice law in Guam; and
3. That, under Rule 24(e) of the Guam Rules for Lawyer Disciplinary Enforcement and Disability Proceedings, Bruce A. Bradley shall remain subject to the continuing jurisdiction of the Supreme Court of Guam and the Comprehensive Lawyer Regulatory System as provided therein.
